

Field Museum of Natural History (founded by Marshall Field in 1893) is located at Roosevelt Road and Lake Michigan, Chicago, Illinois. The extend is of Georgia white marble and is treated in a monumental manner based on Greek architecture of the Ionic order. The building is 700 feet long, 440 feet wide, and 104 feet high and has more than eleven acres of exhibition area.
